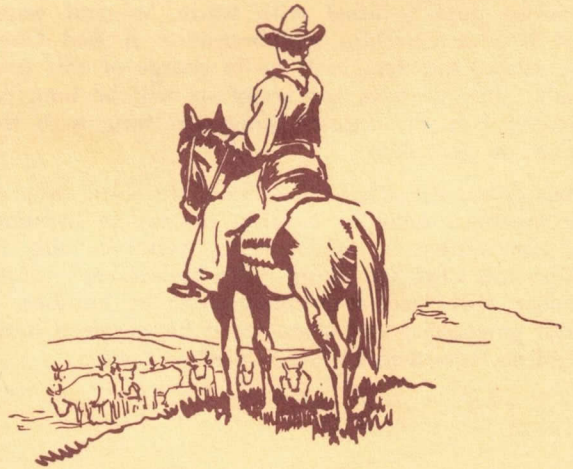

## Where and What

The Double T Dude Ranch is located at Garland Mineral Springs and is operated in conjunction with this Christian Resort. It is the answer to the many requests we have had through the past five years. We now have experienced personnel to operate the children's ranch in accordance with the high standards we try to maintain at Garland Mineral Spring.

Three bunk houses have been renovated to house the young ranchers, plus the Corral room for fun and fellowship. The main meals will be served family-style in the Lodge dining room on white tablecloths under proper supervision. Some meals will be served out-of-doors, in both picnic and camp style.

The horses have been carefully selected, and the trips on horseback will be through some of the most scenic forest and mountain terrain to be found in the Pacific Northwest.

The swimming facilities are unsurpassed, for the 105-foot pool is filled with warm, mineral water that is both healthful and buoyant. A Red Cross life saving instructor will be in charge of this program. The firesides and songfests will be long remembered as the western songs are sung with the guitar or accordion.

Throughout the whole day, from devotion time at the breakfast table to evening prayers at bedtime, the atmosphere is conducive to personal faith in Christ and Christian living. We believe each young rancher will receive encouragement in building a better personality and character as he vacations here. Children, ages 8 to 16, are invited to come.

## What to Bring

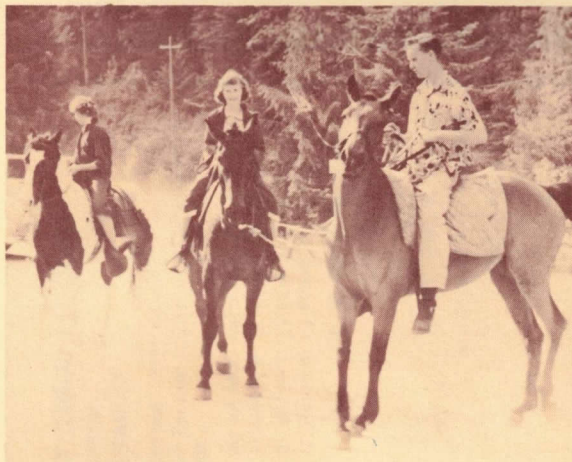
Jeans, shirts, warm jackets, comfortable shoes, sleeping bag if possible for overnight trip.

## Rates, Arrivals and Departures

The weekly rate is \$60 per week. Discounts from 5 to 15 per cent for longer periods. A deposit of at least \$10 per week is required with each reservation. We are not obligated to make refunds after June 1.



Children will be received any time during the day Sunday, except during the morning worship service from 10:30 to 12. The same regulations apply to the time for the children to leave. Luggage will be picked up and left, and financial arrangements will be made at the Corral Room. If children are here for the second Sunday dinner, the additional charges will be \$1.50. The children's Sunday dinner will be served between one and two o'clock.
